Overview

If you are traveling to Germany, you will need a power adapter that is compatible with the German electrical outlets. The type of plug used in Germany is the Europlug (Type C) or the Schuko. Which power outlets do they use in Germany?

Two different types of electrical sockets are found in Germany: Type C, which has two round holes, and Type F, which has two round holes and two grounding clips. Power sockets in Germany

German houses have Type F power outlets. 1 They are also called Schuko or CEE 7/3 sockets. This is the same socket as in most European countries, and many Asian countries.

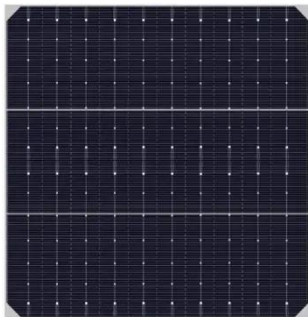


Plugs, sockets and voltage in Germany

If you have plugs with flat pins, such as those used in the US, or three-pin plugs as used in the UK and Ireland, they will not work in German plug sockets, and you will need an adapter.

Germany electrical outlets : need a travel adapter?

If you are traveling to Germany, you will need a power adapter that is compatible with the German electrical outlets. In Germany, the standard voltage is 230 volts, and the frequency is 50 Hz.
