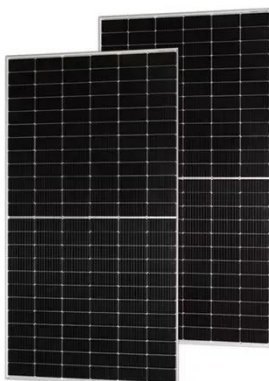

Cook Islands Electric Outlets & Plugs

The voltage in the Cook Islands is 240 volts, and the frequency is 50 Hz. Travelers visiting the Cook Islands should ensure they have a power adapter that supports type I sockets.

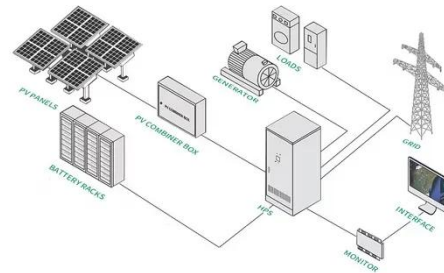

The power sockets on the Cook Islands are of type I. The standard voltage is 240 V at a frequency of 50 Hz. Check your need for a power plug (travel) adapter on the Cook Islands.

Cook Islands uses power plugs and sockets of Type I, with a standard voltage of 240 V and a frequency of 50 Hz. If your devices are compatible with these specifications, you will not need a power adapter.

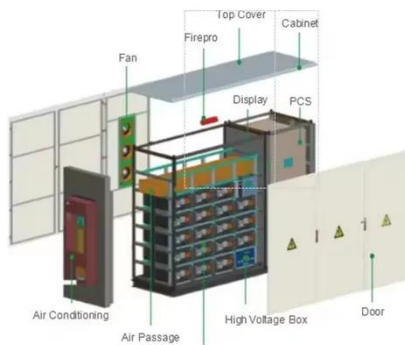
