How big an inverter should I use for a 5 kW solar system



Overview

The inverter converts the direct current (DC) electricity generated by your solar panels into alternating current (AC) that powers your home appliances. For example, a 5 kW solar array typically. A solar inverter should closely match your solar system's output in kW—typically within 80% to 120% of your total panel capacity. Too small = wasted energy

A 6.5 kW solar array pairs well with a 5–6 kW inverter. Occasional inverter clipping during peak sun hours is very normal and often more cost effective than upsizing. A properly sized solar inverter typically lasts 10–15 years, though premium or microinverter units can reach 20–25 years with good maintenance. Think of inverter sizing like choosing the right-sized engine for your car. Too small, and you'll struggle on hills.

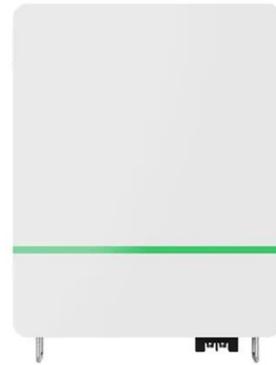
