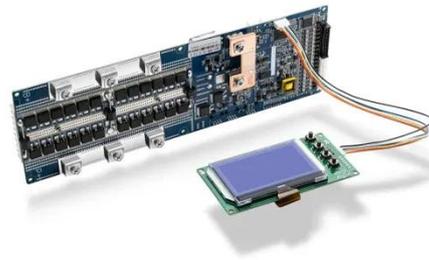
The crew were heard on VHF air-band frequency reporting that some of the load of five heavy military vehicles in the
