KUALA LUMPUR (Sept 3): Companies linked to at least seven listed firms have received letters of notification from industry regulator Energy Commission (EC) as shortlisted bidders for large-scale solar (LSS) projects under the latest LSS5+ bidding round. Meanwhile, sources said YTL Power International Bhd (KL: YTLPOWR) had been shortlisted for a 100MW solar farm in Kelantan, while Tenaga Nasional Bhd (KL: TENAGA) is a frontrunner for a floating solar project as well. The projects will attract total investments exceeding 4 Billion Saudi Riyals (1.06 Billion USD) and will contribute to supplying power to approximately 265,000 residential units annually.
