Brazil's climate change policies

Brazil last updated its NDC in March 2022, confirming its commitment to reducing its GHG emissions by 37 % by the year 2025 and by 50 % by the year 2030 as compared with 2005.

Low Carbon Cities: Curitiba and Brasilia

These results illustrate how spatial attributes in metropolitan Brasilia translate into much higher carbon intensity rates due to more auto travel than Curitiba and surrounding municipalities.
