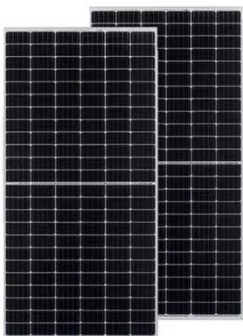


Renewable energy in Tuvalu
